Cookies are harmless text files that web servers can store on your computer's hard drive when you visit a website.

They allow the server to recognise you when you revisit. We do not use data from which you can be individually identified.

Internet cookies are common and do not harm your system – they just store or gather site information. They help you do things online, like remembering login details so you don't have to re-enter them when revisiting a website.

- We don't use cookies to track people's Internet usage after leaving our site
